# 15th Serbian Conference on Spectral Line Shapes in Astrophysics (15th SCSLSA) June 9-13, 2025; Niš, Serbia

## FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear colleagues,

The Organizing Committee is pleased to inform you that "15th Serbian Conference on Spectral Line Shapes in Astrophysics" will be held in the city of Niš, Serbia, in the period 9-13 June 2025.

#### SCIENTIFIC RATIONALE

Spectral lines, their widths, and, more generally, their shapes are powerful diagnostic tools for probing emitting/absorbing gas in different astrophysical objects, from the solar system to the most distant objects in the universe – quasars. The emission/absorption lines of astrophysical objects are produced over a wide range of distances from an observer and under a wide range of physical and kinematic conditions. Therefore, lines from the X-ray domain (e.g., Fe  $\alpha$ ) to the radio spectrum (e.g., radio recombination lines), have been the focus of extensive study in these objects. In parallel with observational research, experimental and theoretical investigations of laboratory plasmas are needed for spectroscopic astrophysical research; in particular, the same atomic data are needed for line-shape calculations. This conference will bring together astronomers (observers and theoreticians) and physicists from Serbia and elsewhere to review the present stage of research, with the aim of improving our knowledge in this field, and to better understand the significance of emission/absorption lines for future astrophysical investigations.

# The program will cover:

- Stellar and interstellar spectral lines
- Spectral line phenomena in extragalactic objects
- Spectral lines in laboratory and general plasma
